## SMALL COMFORTS 2025 BOXED-IN

Pattern from Candy Cane Fabrics, Free on the internet

Finished quilt ~43" x 51" You may make it larger by adding optional borders

Fabric requirements: 30- 10" squares

Suggestions for fabrics:

15 Children's prints with 15 "show as solid" colored squares
15 light squares and 15 dark squares
15 one color with a variety of fabrics and 15 of another color with a variety of fabrics
30 squares from a layer cake
Your choice of 30 squares!

Supplies needed:

Ruler Cutting mat and rotary cutter Any other sewing supplies that you need, bobbins, thread, seam ripper (perish the thought!)

DIRECTIONS:

1. Start by layering your 10" squares, 2 or more at a time depending on your comfort level for cutting multiple layers.





Cut these squares in half

2. From one of these halves, cut (2) 2.5" x 10" rectangles



3. From the other half, cut (1) 5" square and (2) 5" x 2.5" rectangles.



- 4. You are now ready to SEW, SEW, SEW!! At this point, you may mix up your squares, or only do two at a time. It is up to you how you want to "juggle" your squares.
- 5. Sew a matching 5" x 2.5" rectangle to the top and bottom of a different square.



- 6. Press away from the center square.
- 7. Sew a matching rectangle to the top and bottom of the 5" square. Trim away the small excess pieces to make your squares about 9" unfinished. Press away from the center square.





- 8. You may mix up your prints, colors, and values as you wish to "balance" the quilt.
- 9. Sew the remaining blocks in this way for a total of 30 blocks. It goes really fast if you chain piece.
- 10. Lay your blocks out in a 5 x 6 layout. Sew the blocks together. Baste and quilt! It will look awesome.
